




Morning Screening

- Upon arrival, our dedicated screener will be asking parent/guardian question's about their health
- Screener will also be taking temperature of the parent/guardian and child(ren) making sure everyone is starting their day on a good note
- Our dedicated runner will be bringing your child(ren) safely to their classrooms and updating their teachers with messages from parent/guardian
- Screener/Runner will be disinfecting belonging's prior to entering the centre





Safety Precautions

- Once the child is safely brought to their cohort room, teachers will guide them to wash their hands before going into program
- Teachers will be using blankets as barriers to carry and comfort the children
- All children's belongings will be washed and remain at the centre, to avoid cross contamination
- Children will only be playing on the playground with Cohort Group


